SCCER Roadmap Workshop

On June 15, 2015, representatives from all SCCERs met for a roadmap workshop discussing mobility, decentralisation, industry partners and storage. Collaboration within the different SCCERs was one of the main topics being looked at. In the first part of the workshop, each SCCER presented its roadmap, also showing in which direction each roadmap will develop in the second phase. Afterwards, the representatives

aimed at identifying research overlaps and interfaces, where common projects (with participation of at least two SCCERs) could be possible. „How can we move from central production and decentralised consumption to energy regions?“ and „What are the driving forces which make industries interested in collaboration and how do we cooperate with industry partners?“ were some of the questions raised in this meeting.

A second roadmap workshop will be organized in August/September 2015 by the ETH Zurich.

Workshop Workpackage 2

A CREST WP 2 workshop on the planned Swiss Household Energy Demand Survey (SHEDS) took place on June 17, 2015 at the University of Neuchâtel. By surveying a rolling panel of 10'000 households in 5 annual waves, the SHEDS mainly aims to track Swiss households' energy behavior and its determinants over time in three domains (heating, electricity, mobility). The aim of the meeting in Neuchâtel, which was well attended by CREST and other SCCER researchers alike, was to provide participants with an overview on ongoing research projects related to the SHEDS. In addition, the workshop provided participants with a platform to provide constructive feedback on the structure and content of the survey.
